1	Oral Cancer	To give due diligence and importance to Oral Cancer Awareness and Screening and Tobacco cessation, The Dental Council of India is collaborating with the AIIMS New Delhi to start the Oral Cancer Awareness Programme. Such initiatives will be taken up in other centres throughout India
2	Oral Health Survey	In order to get current national data on the oral diseases and the dentist population ratio, prevalence of oral diseases in both urban and rural populations, a National Oral Health Survey will be conducted
3	Bridge Course	In order to improve the accessibility to health care especially during emergency situation in the rural areas, the DCI is planning to start a bridge course for BDS graduates to bring them to the MBBS levels

4	Appointment of Dentists in PHC, and CHC, through UPSC	Despite the availability of dentists, the utilization of oral health services in India is low due to high costs involved in oral health care and non-absorption of dentists in the public sector. It should be recognized that under the crunch of human resource in the public health sector, the registered dental graduates in India can prove to be an excellent resource and enhancing appointment opportunities for dentists in PHCs and CHCs through the existing UPSC dental surgeon exam should be considered.
5	Establishment of Research Wing in all Dental Colleges	Inculcating a research bent of mind among the faculty and students of all dental colleges is now a pressing priority. A research wing has to be established in all Dental colleges affiliated to the DCI to dutifully encourage faculty and students to identify and avail the opportunities for sharing of evidence-based knowledge, skills and best practices with thrust on collaborative research projects and high-quality publications in indexed journals.

The colleges should furnish a certified copy of the accreditation Certificate issued by NAAC, to the DCI.

7	Exit Examination	As per the Draft Bill proposed by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare in Feb 2020, all students who have graduated from a Dental college in India or dental graduates with a foreign degree will be required to appear for an exit exam, aptly named as National Exit Test or NEXT. The exam will be designed as a screening test to qualify BDS graduates for MDS programs in India along with qualifying them a license to practice their profession across the nation
