**ELIGIBILITY FEES**

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination outside Karnataka shall pay the Eligibility Fees of Rs.2640/- to the University in addition to the regular fees (for I B.P.Ed only).

**FEES CONCESSION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR SC/ST CANDIDATES:**

I) The SC/ST Candidates (admitted to University Department/Constituent Colleges) within Karnataka and whose parents annual income is less than or equal to Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh fifty thousand only) as per annum shall pay the following fees subject to submission of the photocopies of the following valid documents /certificates at the time of admission. #

- (a) Rs.300/- (Rupees three hundred and thirty only) excluding \* reimbursable compulsory fees for regular seats  
 and  
 (b) Rs.300/- (Rupees three hundred and thirty only) excluding reimbursable compulsory fees plus payment fees (the concession fees prescribed under (column 4) for payment seat. The other (compulsory) fees of SC/ST candidates will be reimbursed from the Social Welfare Department (ಸರ್ಕಾರದ ಆದೇಶ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆ: ಸಕೆ, 83 ಪಕವಿ 2013, ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು ದಿನಾಂಕ:27.06.2013)



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1. Online acknowledgment (Post-Metric application) 15 digits Registration No. of Social Welfare Department.
  2. Caste Certificate issued in Karnataka by the Tahsildar, within last five years.
  3. Parents Income Certificate issued in Karnataka by the Tahsildar (valid date)
  4. Previous month's salary certificates of parents who are working in any government / Semi-Government/ Private sector.
  5. SSLC / CBSE / ISCE Marks card (Candidate studied in Karnataka only)
  6. Aadhar Card
  7. Previous year Marks Card
  8. Bank Pass book (Bank account should be in the name of the Candidate)

**THE FOLLOWING SC/ST CANDIDATES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO CLAIM FEE REIMBURSEMENT**

- (a) SC / ST students from other states.
- (b) SC / ST students of Karnataka whose parents' annual income is more than Rs.2,50,000/-.
- (c) SC / ST candidates who are seeking admission to B.P.Ed Course after claiming scholarship in B.Ed course (B.Ed discontinued is also taken into account).

The above candidates shown at (a), (b) & (c) shall pay the prescribed course fees and examination fees.

**II) CAT-I, 2A, 3A & 3B AND OTHER STUDENTS SHALL PAY THE PRESCRIBED FEES.**

As per ಸರ್ಕಾರದ ಆದೇಶ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆ: ಒಂವಕ 589 ಬಿಎಂಎಸ್ 2013, ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು ದಿನಾಂಕ:05.10.2013, Cat-I candidates whose parents' annual income is less than or equal to Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two lakh fifty thousand only) and candidates irrespective of caste / community / Religion, 2A, 3A, 3B and others) who have studied for a period of 7 (Seven) academic years (Commencing from 1<sup>st</sup> standard up to the qualifying examination either continuously or in broken period) and whose parents' Annual income is less than or equal to Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) are eligibility claim the reimbursement of Tuition, Laboratory, Library, Sports and Examination fees. The reimbursement of fees will be credited by the Backward classes Welfare Department (BCWD) only to such students who are eligible as per the norms of Government of Karnataka [www.karepass.cgg.gov.in](http://www.karepass.cgg.gov.in); of the BCWD.

III) The candidates belonging to minorities (i.e. Muslims, Christians, Buddhists, Sikhs, Anglo-Indians, Jains etc.) whose Parents' Annual Income is less than Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Only) are eligible to apply for Encouragement Fund / Fees reimbursement from Minorities Welfare Department (MWD) as per the norms of MWD.

The office of the Registrar (Evaluation) shall notify the prescribed examination & convocation fee only.

The Principal, University College of Physical Education, Bangalore University shall ensure that the students whose admissions are not approved by the University / having shortage of attendance and those students who do not fulfill the requirement shall not be allowed to appear for the examination.

The eligible students shall pay the prescribed examination fees prior to that semester examination within the stipulated date for payment of fees as notified by the Registrar (Evaluation), Examination Branch. The SC/ST candidates within Karnataka and whose parents annual income is less than or equal to Rs.2,50,000/- (Two Lakh fifty thousand only) per annum shall pay only the OMR fees of Rs.15/-, since the prescribed fees will be reimbursed by the Social Welfare Department. However, the candidates whose parents' annual income is above Rs.2.5 Lakhs shall pay the prescribed total fees.



The course and examination fees will be reimbursed by the Social Welfare Department to the Bank account of Director of Student's' welfare, BUB in respect of students admitted in University Departments / Constituent Colleges.

**INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPAL, UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, BANGALORE UNIVERSITY FOR CLAIMING REIMBURSEMENT OF LOSS OF FEE OF SC / ST STUDENTS FROM THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT.**

The Principal, UCPE Bangalore University shall verify whether the candidates has filled the prescribed fee with examination fees and forward the online (Post-Matric) scholarship application of SC / ST students along with the documents # for claiming reimbursement of loss of fee from the Social Welfare Department, Government of Karnataka.

The Principal, UCPE, Bangalore University Departments shall ascertain the receipt of fees reimbursement from the Social welfare Department with the office of the Director, Student Welfare, BUB. In case of non-receipt of Fees reimbursement for what-so-ever reasons mentioned therein by the Social Welfare Department, such students shall be directed to pay the prescribed Regular fees and Odd & Even semester Examination fees before appearing for the even semester Examination.
