Sub: Payment of admission fee for II year P.G. courses for the academic year 2023-24-reg.

The last date for payment of Admission fee for II year PG courses for the academic year 2023-24 as prescribed in the notification dated 04.11.2022 (cited at ref (1)) is as notified below: (2022-23 Batch)

1	Payment of prescribed fee through on-line/e-payment without fine.	12.01.2024
2	Prescribed fee through on-line/e-payment with a fine of Payment Rs. 200/-	15.01.2024

1. The II year P.G. students of Bangalore University Departments/constituent Colleges/PG centre shall remit the prescribed fee as per the Notification on or before the dates mentioned above.
2. Students shall pay the Regular seat fee through UUCMS portal.
3. The students admitted under payment seat category has to pay the payment seat fee through **website <http://bangaloreuniversity.karnataka.gov.in>** and upload the receipt in UUCMS portal.
4. The students who are admitted under Payment seat Category shall have to pay the payment Seat fees (through Bangalore University website) and Regular fee (through UUCMS portal) Payment seat fee will not be reimbursed by the Social Welfare Department/Backward Classes Welfare Department/Minorities Welfare Department to the students .
5. The Chairpersons/Coordinators/Directors of the concerned Departments and Principals of the Constituent Colleges of Bangalore University shall direct their Office staff to verify the Caste/Income certificates as per the instructions below and also as in notification dated 04.11.2022 for availing the fee concession by SC/ST students,etc.
6. The students shall submit the Fee receipt along with Caste & Income Certificate (if any) to the concerned Department/College office.

Note:

1. The marks cards/ certificates shall not be issued/letters shall not be forwarded to the higher-ups until the dues are cleared by the respective student.
2. The Registrar (Evaluation) shall insist for NO DUE CERTIFICATE from the students issued from the respective department before issuing the Degree Certificate (only in the case of BU Departments/ constituent colleges/PG Centre students).
3. Last date for Applying to Backward Classes Scholarship is 10th January 2024. Hence, students belonging to other backward classes(OBC) shall pay the fees immediately and apply for backward classes Scholarship before 10th January 2024 without fail

With effect from the year 2023-24, the Government of India in consultation with the Department of Education and the Department of Social Welfare, has directed that the students belonging to SC/ST category whose annual income of the family is less than Rs.2.5 Lakhs and are eligible for the post-matric scholarship shall be provided free education (excluding non reimbursable fee/deposit amount if any) without having to pay any compulsory fees at the time of admission.

Hence, the students admitted to the following courses shall pay the fees which are not entitled for reimbursement from the Social Welfare Department i.e., Cultural activity (Rs.100/-), Student activity fee (Rs.100/-), User Fee (Rs.100/-), Study tour fee (Rs.1,600/-) / Industrial visit fee (Rs.2000/-):

1. II year M.A. in Kannada/ Kannada Taulanika/ Theatre Arts (Rs.1,900/-)
2. II year M.Sc. in Applied Geology /Applied Genetics/Geography/ Botany (Rs.1,900/-)
3. II Year M.Sc. FAD (Rs.2300/-)
4. II year M.Com/MTTM (Rs.2300/-)
5. for other courses of II year (Rs.300/-)

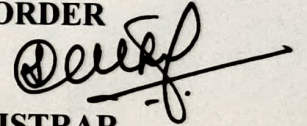
However, they shall submit the freship card (which can be downloaded from State Scholarship Portal-SSP) to concerned department/PG Centre within 31-01-2024, failing which, they are liable for payment of balance of admission fee.

The Chairperson/ Co-ordinators of Bangalore University Departments/ Director, PG Centre and Principal, UCPE shall direct the SC/ST students (who have taken admission without pre-payment of compulsory fee of the respective course) to pay the Balance of course fee received from the Social Welfare Department, Government of Karnataka, i.e., fees due to be paid at the time of admission, prior to payment of even semester examination fee. **In case of non-receipt of Fees reimbursement** for what so-ever reasons mentioned therein /short payment of fee reimbursement by the Social Welfare Department, **such students shall also be directed to pay the balance of course/Admission fees in full** (which was due to be paid at the time of admission) / prior to payment of even semester examination fee.

The original marks cards submitted by the student at the time of admission and /or other documents (PG examination marks card, Degree Certificate/PDC, TC etc..) shall not be issued until the students clear all the dues to the University Department/PG centre/UCPE.

Students belonging to SC/ST category of other State and SC/ST students of Karnataka whose family annual income is above Rs.2.50 Lakhs shall pay full fees.
