

ADMISSION TO MBA (DAY) COURSE

**1. ELIGIBILITY - MBA DAY COURSE**

**MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- A graduate degree under 10+2+3 or 10+2+4 pattern under any discipline securing at least 50% marks in aggregate including languages from a recognized University in India or abroad.
- Honors degree under 10+2+4 pattern from a recognized university under UGC Act having at least 50% marks in aggregate including languages.
- Candidates who have passed bachelor / master degree through correspondence / Open University system from this university or from any other university recognized by law are exempted from 10+2 pattern. The duration of the degrees must be three and two years respectively.
- Candidates who pass bachelor/master degree in any university system in single sitting pattern are not eligible.
- In case of SC/ST/Cat-I candidates, there will be a relaxation of 5% in the aggregate of marks obtained.
- All admissions to CBSMS and affiliated colleges will be made through an entrance test conducted by appropriate body as approved by Government of Karnataka and State Level Counseling based on Rank Merit and the reservation rules based on the seat matrix as announced by the Government of Karnataka from time to time.

**DURATION OF THE COURSE**

The duration of the MBA program shall extend over 4 semesters (two academic years) of 16 weeks or more each with a minimum of 90 actual working days of instruction in each semester and 2 to 3 weeks of examinations.

**MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION**

The medium of instruction for all subjects and examination shall be English only.

**ADMISSION TO MBA EVENING COURSE : 2023-24**

**1. ELIGIBILITY – MBA EVENING COURSE**

- A graduate degree under **10+2+3** or **10+2+4** pattern under any discipline securing at least 50% (45% for SC/ST and category-1 candidates of Karnataka) marks in aggregate including languages from a recognized university.
- Honors degree under **10+2+4** pattern from a recognized university under UGC Act having at least 50% (45% for SC/ST and category-1 candidates of Karnataka) marks in aggregate including languages. The applicants must also be Karnataka students as defined by the Government of Karnataka from time to time.
- Candidates who have passed bachelor / master degree through correspondence / Open University system from this university or from any other university recognized by law are exempted from 10+2 pattern. The duration of the degrees must be 3 years 2 years respectively.
- Candidates who pass bachelor/master degree in any university system in single sitting pattern are not eligible.
- A minimum of two years after graduation full-time supervisory experience in any organization. A minimum of two years of work experience after graduation in any Public / Private sector organization is essential.
- In the case of teaching/non-teaching staff working in the university or affiliated colleges, a two/five years of full-time teaching/administrative experience is essential.
- The Admission to the program will be effected through admission test conducted by the Bangalore University.

**2. INTAKE OF THE PROGRAMME**

- The number of seats shall be limited a maximum of 60 in a class.
- Reservation of Seats for admission will be as per the Government & University Orders from time to time.

**3. DURATION OF THE COURSE**

- The course is spread over four semesters in two years. Each semester is for a period of four months and each semester covers six courses of hundred marks each, as detailed in course structure.
- The first semester provides the foundation to management; the second semester introduces the functional areas of management.

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- The third and fourth semesters focus on complementary and elective courses. The Program offers a wide choice to the students with functional/sectoral areas of specialization to choose from.

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**4. WORK LOAD**

The class workload per week amounts to 24 - 28 hours of contact sessions. The courses are listed either as 6 credits or 3 credits indicating the classroom contact hours prescribed for each course.

**5. WORKING HOURS**

Monday to Saturday : 6.00 P.M to 9.00 P.M

Sunday : 9.00 A.M to 4.00 P.M

**6. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION**
